**Product data sheet** 

## 1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a TO252 (DPAK) surface mountable plastic package. This triac balances the requirements of commutation performance and gate sensitivity and is intended for interfacing with low power drivers and logic ICs including microcontrollers. This "series ET" triac will commutate the full rated RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature ( $T_{i(max)} = 150$  °C) without the aid of a snubber.

### 2. Features and benefits

- High commutation capability with maximum false trigger immunity
- Direct interfacing with low level power drivers and logic ICs
- High junction operating temperature capability (T<sub>i(max)</sub> = 150 °C)
- Planar passivated for voltage ruggedness and reliability





Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values

Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values




Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values





Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values




Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration




Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature





Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage




Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature





Fig. 12. Rate of change of commutating current as a function of junction temperature; typical and minimum values
