Intermediate level gate drive N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using advanced TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC Q101 standard for use in high performance automotive applications.







Normalized total power dissipation as a Fig 2. function of mounting base temperature








Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig 7. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values





Fig 6. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

Fig 8. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values.




Fig 9. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage




Fig 11. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 10. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





Fig 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature



Fig 13. Gate charge waveform definitions








Fig 15. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

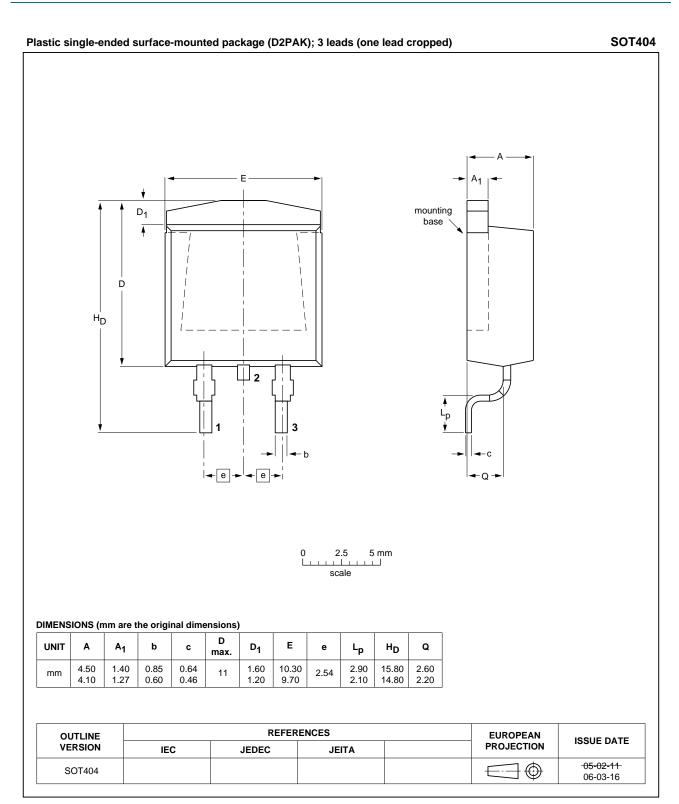


Fig 17. Package outline SOT404 (D2PAK)
