

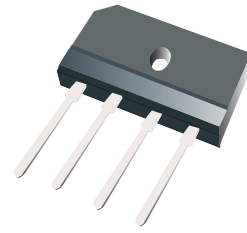

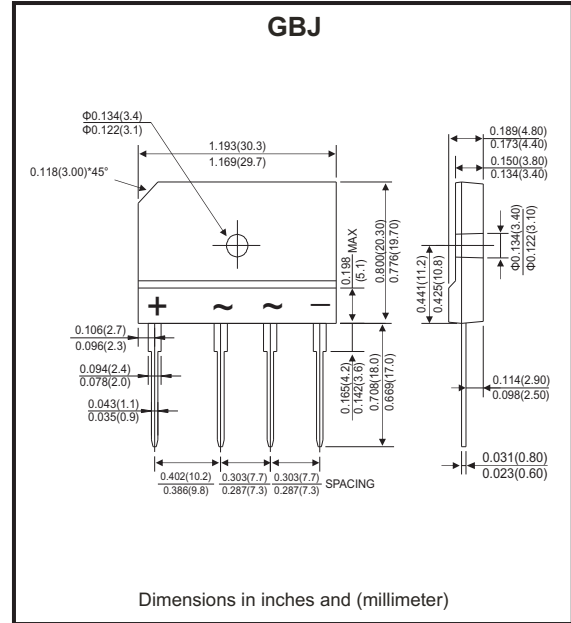

Fig.1 - Forward Current Derating Curve

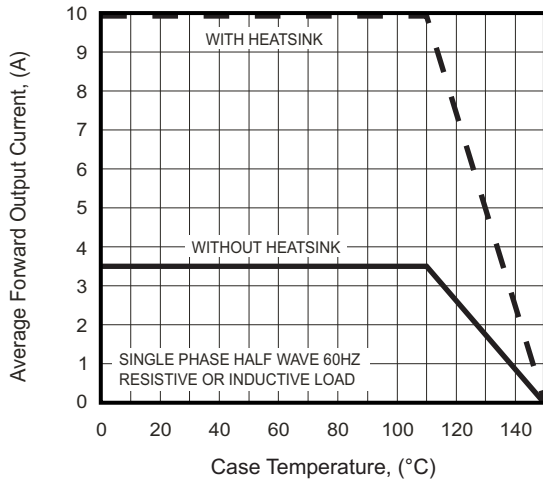


Fig.2 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current

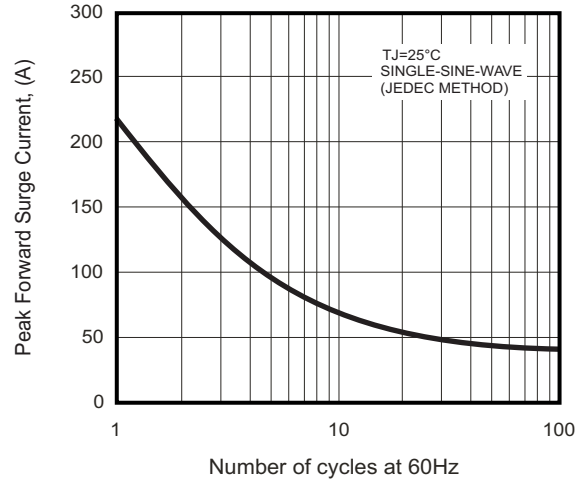


Fig.3 - Typical Junction Capacitance

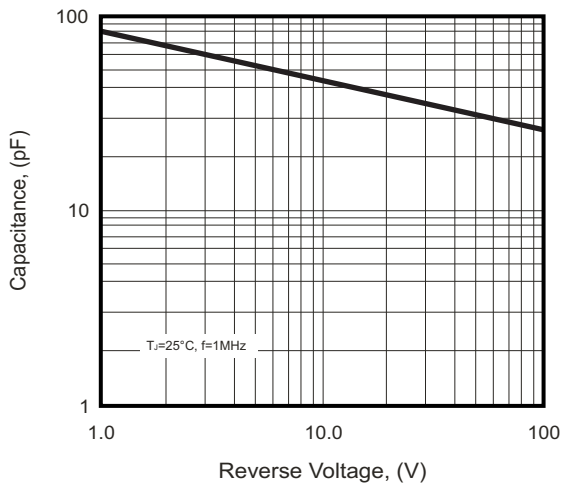


Fig.4 - Typical Forward Characteristics

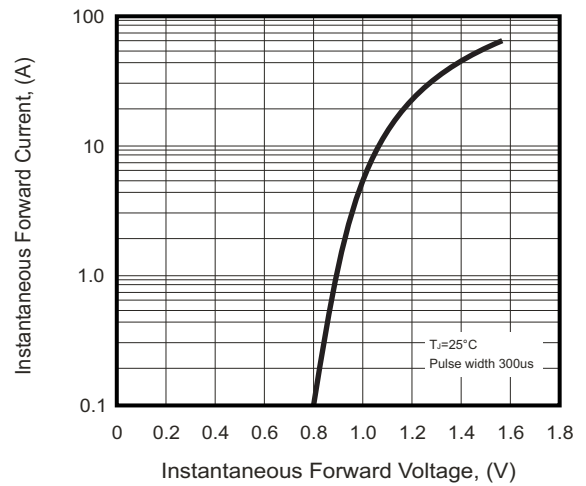
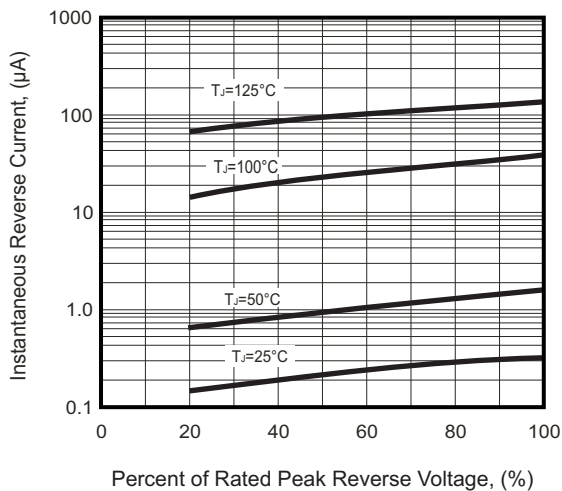


Fig.5 - Typical Reverse Characteristics



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
