

# TinyLogic UHS 3-Input NAND Gate

## NC7SZ10

### Description

The NC7SZ10 is a single 3-Input NAND Gate from ON Semiconductor's Ultra High Speed Series of TinyLogic. The device is fabricated with advanced CMOS technology to achieve ultra high speed with high output drive while maintaining low static power dissipation over a broad  $V_{CC}$  operating range. The device is specified to operate over the 1.65 V to 5.5 V  $V_{CC}$  operating range. The inputs and output are high impedance when  $V_{CC}$  is 0 V. Inputs tolerate voltages up to 5.5 V independent of  $V_{CC}$  operating voltage.

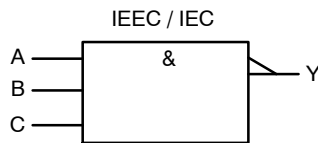


Figure 1. Logic Symbol



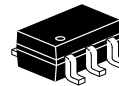
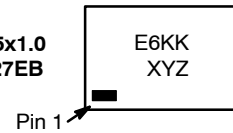
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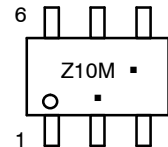

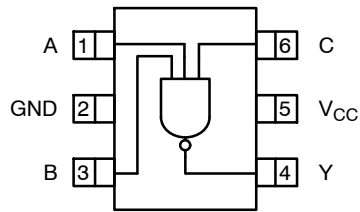


Figure 2. SC-88 (Top View)

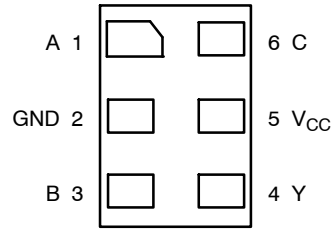
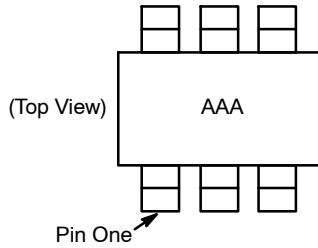


Figure 4. MicroPak (Top Through View)

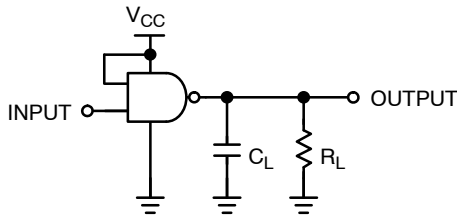

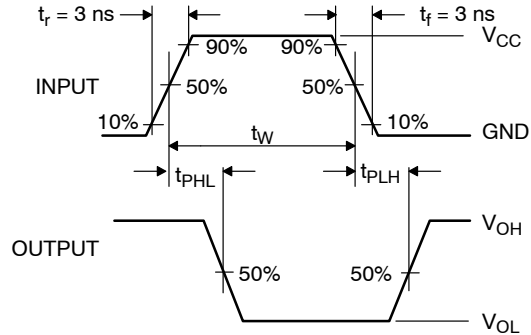

C<sub>PD</sub> is defined as the value of the internal equivalent capacitance which is derived from dynamic operating current consumption (I<sub>CCD</sub>) at no output loading and operating at 50% duty cycle. (See Figure 6) C<sub>PD</sub> is related to I<sub>CCD</sub> dynamic operating current by the expression:  
I<sub>CCD</sub> = (C<sub>PD</sub>) (V<sub>CC</sub>) (f<sub>IN</sub>) + (I<sub>CC</sub>static).

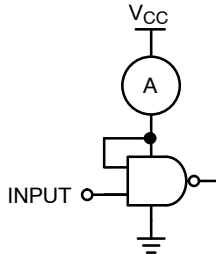

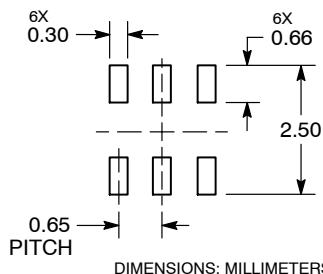
